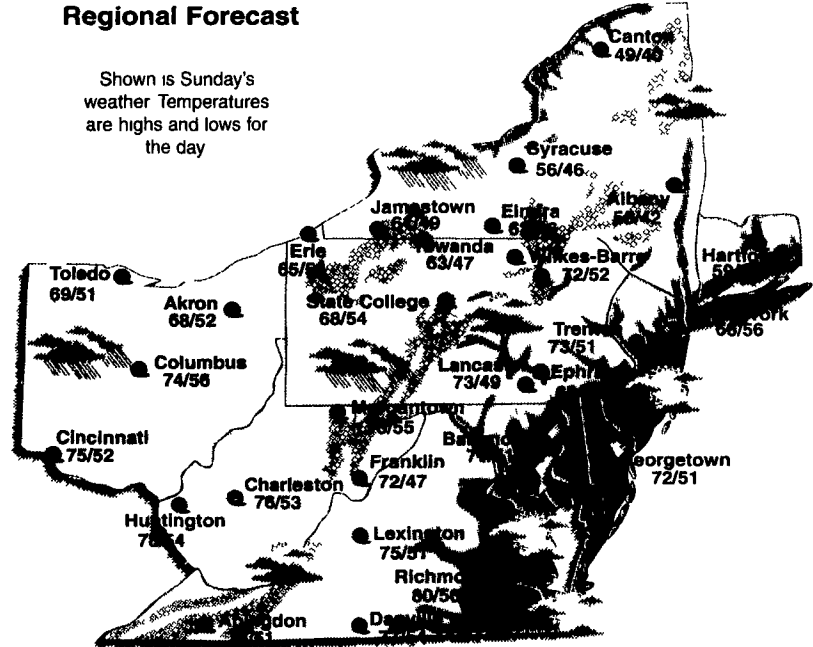

Farming Forecast

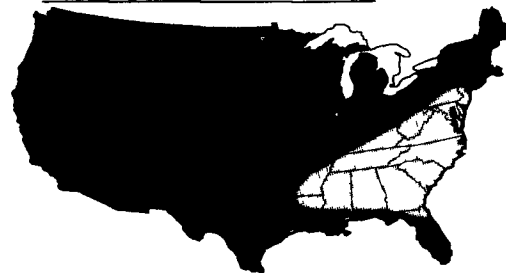

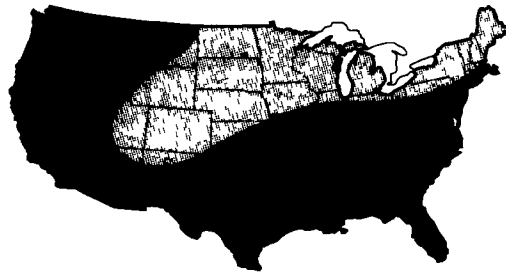

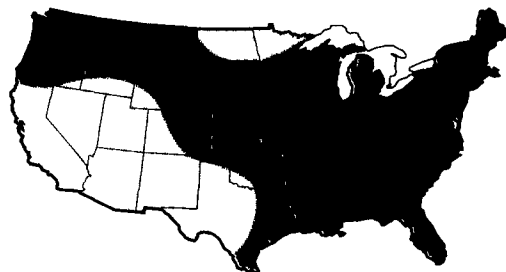
