DOYLESTOWN (Bucks Co.) — Bucks County 4-H Swine Club members showed and sold their market hogs recently at the Middletown Grange Fair in Wrightstown. The judge was Todd Benekoff of Kutztown.

Ben Crooke, New Hope won grand champion honors with his

234-pound hog bought by Newtown Heating and Air Conditioning for \$460.

Leidy's Inc. of Souderton purchased the 213-pound reserve champion which was shown by Josh Crooke, Ben's brother, for \$380.

The Champion Pair was also shown by Josh Crooke, and they were purchased by R & S Equipment and the Bucks County 4-H Sheep club for \$710 each.

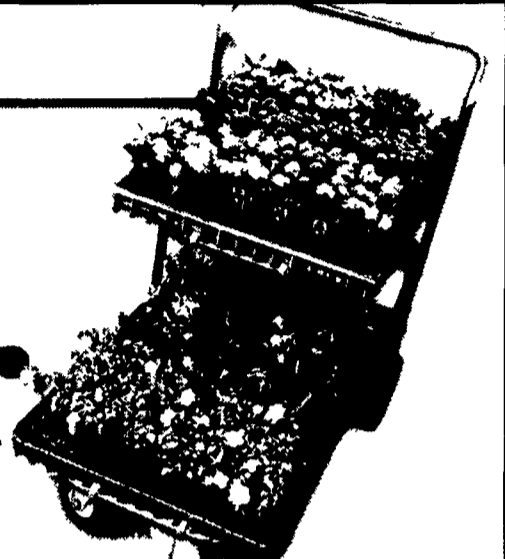
