All pigs continue to go to slaughter as mandated. Pigs consigned to the Wednesday sale are graded on arrival, and sold on their in-weights. Prices are quoted per hundred weight. The Graded run consisted of 59 percent Graded 1-2's and 18 percent Graded 2's.
