LEESBURG, Va. — The Marion duPont Scott Equine Medical Center has been awarded a \$25,000 grant from Thoroughbred Charities of America. Grant funds are designated for building research facilities to enable collaborative research efforts to benefit equine health. The Equine Medical Center, located in Leesburg, Virginia, is one of three campuses comprising the Virginia-Maryland Regional College of Park campus in Maryland, and Veterinary Medicine, a two-state professional school with major campus facilities at Virginia Tech in Blacksburg and the University of Maryland at College Park.

Research facilities to be constructed on the Leesburg campus will facilitate greater collaboration among faculty and graduate students at the Equine Medical Center, the VMRCVM's College

Virginia Tech's Middleburg Agricultural Research and Extension Center. The laboratory's Northern Virginia location will also facilitate collaboration with other private and public research groups to promote the health and well being of horses in the Mid-Atlantic region and beyond.

"Virginia Tech President, Charles Steger, has a vision for

the university to be placed among the top 30 research institutions in the country by 2010," said Dr. Nathaniel A. White II, Interim Director of the Equine Medical Center. "The Equine Medical Center's faculty, along with faculty at the Blacksburg campus, Maryland campus and the MARE Center will be a part of the effort to achieve President Steger's vision. Through collaboration with other research units. we look forward to creating new knowledge about equine health to benefit horses everywhere. We are grateful to Thoroughbred Charities of America and its board members for their continued support of our efforts. With this grant and others we have received, TCA will be largely responsible for construction and equipping our research facilities at our Leesburg campus.'
