What You Should Know **Before Buying Prints**

Is that attractive bird or ship print as old as it looks?

These days when supposedly antique prints show up in shops and at auctions for top dollar, you'd best understand the descriptive terms that describe them, and if they are indeed as old as represented.

For a a beginner, print collecting can be a risky business. Rule number one is that when an a specific artist and his works become popular, faking is a foregone conclusion. Even artist Albert Durer had problems with the faking and copying of his prints back in 1512. Copies of his works had become so widespread that the Nuremberg town council wrote a decree making this a crime. Woodblocks and copperplates made reprints easy even in those days.

Back in the 1970s, the growth of the limited editions market created hundreds of Salvador Dali and Pablo Picasso "unlimited editions;" many with faked signatures. They still make the rounds in shops and small auctions as genuine.

Since they were first printed, Audobon birds, sporting prints, and Currier and Ives subjects have been the most reprinted.

When Audobon prints come to auction, prices can vary depending on condition, who the printer was and its rarity. Birds and botanicals can still be discovered, but unfortunately they have often been trimmed to fit a picture frame. They aren't the bargain they seem.

Bird and botanicals usually had their beginnings as part of a book (folio). Like many book illustrations they have been removed from the books and sold separately over the years. While just about everybody has heard of Audubon, less familiar artists such as John Gould, Francois Levaillant, and Edward Lear can still be found at estate and garage sales.

Like Audubon, these artists produced important bird paint-
