Report Supplied By USDA OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS, Weekly Cattle Summary — Compared to last week: Steer and heifer calves steady to 3.00 hugher. Calf demand continues good. Quality of calves average, however flesh conditions are improved for buyers as pasture conditions deteriorate with minor frost. Few feeder steers and heifers steady. Demand for feeder cattle remains good. Numbers of market ready cattle continue to move out of feedlots at or ahead of schedule. This combined with the very limited supplies of feeder cattle has held a good level of demand for feeders.

Receipts this week 8425; last week 11,720; last year 16,286. Supply consisted of 38% yearlings and many calves over 600 lbs; 58% calves; 4% cows & bulls. Heifers comprised 42% of feeder & calf supply.
