Bidding was active, with moderate buyer attendance. All pigs continue to go to slaughter as mandated. Pigs consigned to the Wednesday sale are graded on arrival, and sold on their in-weights. Prices are quoted per hundred weight. The Graded run consisted of 82 percent Graded 1-2's and 10 percent Graded 2's.
