reached over 13,200 youth in Adams County. They have provided

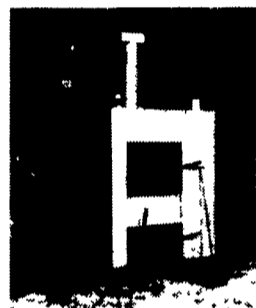
