ABA Ag Committee Vice Chairman Presides Over Conference

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Mike Firestine, vice chairman of the American Bankers Association (ABA) Agriculture Committee, was the presiding officer over the second day (Nov. 11) of ABA's 51st Annual National Ag Conference in San Antonio.

"The conference was developed to educate and motivate agricultural bankers about the challenges and opportunities surrounding the future of agricultural banking," Firestine said. "As the economy tightens, it will take increased dedication, determination and leadership to navigate those challenges."

Firestine introduced speakers before more than 500 agricultural banking professionals from 31 states and Canada. He also marked a moment of silence to remember the nation's veterans as well as remember those who are serving in Iraq.

Speakers include ABA Chairman C. Ken Ferguson; agricultural economist David M. Kohl; as well as president and CEO of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, Robert D. McTeer Jr. These and more than 50 other speakers addressed issues such as: the future of the rural community bank franchise, what happens if mad cow disease is found in the

United States, monetary policies and the economic outlook for 2004, agricultural credit management, emerging farm technology, and tourism as part of rural America's future.

A highlight of the conference was Firestine's announcement of the seventh annual Bruning Award, which recognizes the lifetime achievement of bankers who have dedicated their careers to providing credit and other financial services to rural Americans. This year's award went to B.A. Donelson, chairman, First State Bank in Stratford, Texas. Donelson has been farming and ranching for 45 years and began work in the banking industry in 1967.

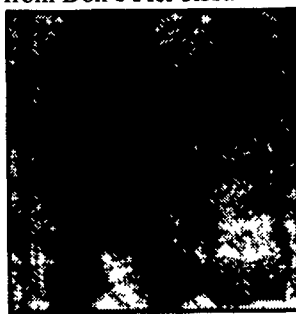
