

Meeting To Organize Manure Hauler Association

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — Many who are in or close to the hauling industry feel that the formation of a manure applicator association can offer many benefits. A few of the benefits an association could provide to the manure application industry are a voice in regulatory development, group insurances and provision of employee benefit packages. These things can positively influence both community image

and profitability. A meeting will be held to discuss the advantages and industry interest in association formation.

Significant industry involvement in this inaugural meeting will be necessary to support the formation of an association. At the minimum manure applicators are encouraged to register and attend the meeting to be informed on the attainable benefits of association involvement.

House Bill 1809, The Commercial Manure Hauler and Broker Certification Act, is currently in committee in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives. This bill calls for a required certification course for commercial manure haulers. The bill could become law in early 2004. A manure applicators association could be influential in determining the final structure of the certification course.

The meeting will be held Tuesday, Dec. 16 at the Dauphin County Agriculture & Resource Center in Dauphin. A dinner for interested parties will begin at 5 p.m. with the business meeting commencing at the end of the

meal. Charge for the dinner will be \$15.
