Marketing Educators Surveying Young Farmers

PHILADELPHIA — Research shows that Pennsylvania farmers are getting older and that fewer young people are interested in becoming farmers.

Dr. Diane Phillips, associate professor and chair of the Department of Marketing at Saint Joseph's University, and Dr. Jason Phillips, assistant professor of marketing at West Chester University, have been awarded a \$50,000 research grant from the Center for Rural Pennsylvania to understand the needs and concerns of young Pennsylvania farmers.

As part of the study, a full-scale survey is being mailed to young farmers throughout the state. The project, entitled "The Future of Farming in Pennsylvania: An Investigation into the Needs and Concerns of Pennsylvania's Young Farmers," is a 14-month study that began in January 2003.

"We believe that if the State of Pennsylvania is to maintain its heritage as a rural state, it must find ways to encourage young farmers to continue farming, as well as promote farming as a personally and financially rewarding occupation to other young people," said Dr. Phillips.

"The findings will be provided to The Center for Rural Pennsylvania to be distributed to key audiences, such as state legislators, non-profit organizations, and farm advocates," she added. "Our policy recommendations will focus on access to capital, the use of direct marketing opportunities, and responses to increasing land values in Pennsylvania that make it difficult to buy land."

The input of every young farmer (18 to 35 years of age) in Pennsylvania is critical to the success of the project. Young farmers who participate in the survey will provide valuable information to researchers who can then offer practical recommendations for farm policies and programs.
