Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending November 22, 2003 were 3% less than the previous week, and 11% more than last year.

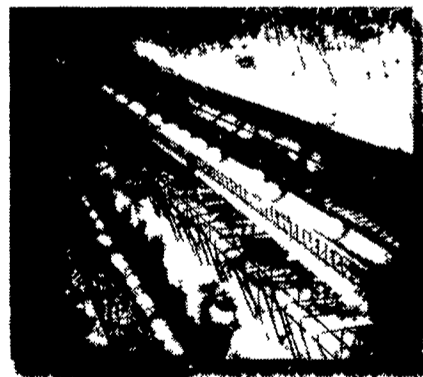
