The National total shell egg inventory was 22% higher than last week. Light type fowl were about sufficient for the light to moderate demand.

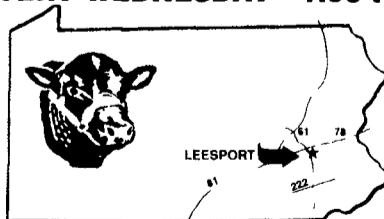
