Our Washington Letter.

WASHINGTON, April 17, '80. It is a hard thing for the extra virtuous Republicans of Massachusetts that all the Presidential candidates who have any probability of nomination are such wicked men as to be unworthy of support; while the candidate they long for is so virtuous that the average Republican will have nothing to do with him.

One good thing is now assured and that is the abolition of the Board of Indian Commissioners. The House decided that question yesterday. This Board has never done any good, while, by a sort of confidence that people generally put in men's numbers, it has made us all less suspicious of the real Indian management of the Interior Department.

When the Indian appropriation bill was yesterday in the House, besides the above important amendment, was offered one to transfer the Indian Bureau to the War Department. Some-thing since I gave the reason urged in favor of this transfer. The change will not, probably be made at this session. A new plan, and one that promises much, is urged now. It is for Congress to authorize the appointment of a sufficient number of gentlemen of standing, to be confirmed by the Senate, who shall prepare a new system of Government for the Indians, to be submitted to the next Congress. It is believed that the importance of the service would induce gentlemen to serve whose recommendations would be entitled to and would receive consideration. It is further urged that the Indians would not suspect such men, as they do the ordinary white man, of being a thief, and so would be glad to have such arrangements.

The subject of the Geneva Award is fairly up in the Senate for discussion. There are above \$10,000,000 remaining in the Treasury to the credit of this fund, and there are three or four ways proposed for the disposition of it. The Judiciary Committee wants to reimburse the Insurance Companies, a substitute for paying the money to the vessel owners, Senator Eaton's bill to turn the money over to reduce the public debt, and fourth, to return the money to England.

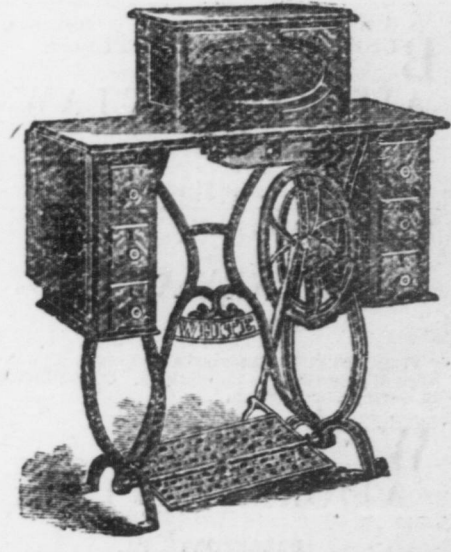

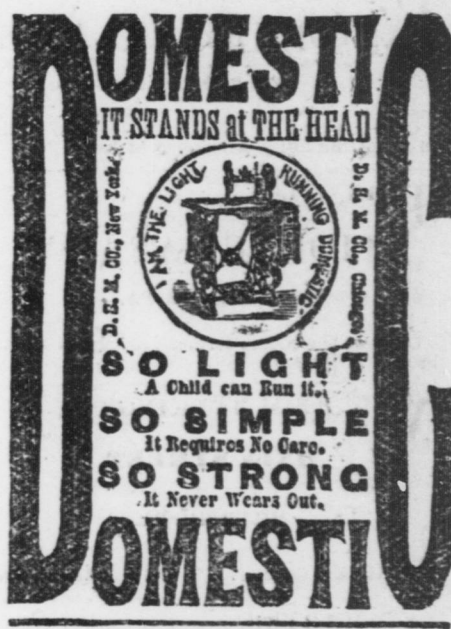
