Judge Blatchford.

Ex-Senator Conkling and Senator Edmunds having both declined the vacant Judgeship of the United States Supreme Court, President Arthur appointed Judge Samuel Blatchford of New York, to the place.

Mormonism Must Go.

On the 14th instant congress passed a bill by a vote of one hundred and ninety-nine yeas to forty-two nays, which gives the death-blow to mormonism, that twin relic of barbarism.

The principal provisions of the bill are that any man living in a State or Territory within the United States who is found cohabiting with more than one woman shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

The Auditors' Report.

The Watchman of last week brings a lengthy article on the report of our county auditors, which we would much like to give to our readers entire.

They report the balance in the hands of the treasurer due the county at \$5,632.58, and the amount of outstanding taxes, Jan. 1st, 1882, at \$50,166.85.

The overcharges in the Sheriff's account amount to a total of \$1,612.90, as stated in the JOURNAL two weeks ago.

Besides this the auditors report that the sum of \$465.07 was paid out to sundry persons on orders issued by the commissioners without warrant of law.

In closing their report the auditors severely criticize the sheriff and commissioners for the manner in which they conducted their business and kept their accounts.

"The amount thus shown to be due the county from the late sheriff and board of commissioners was entered on the probatory's docket as a lien against them and their bondsmen on Wednesday last and the new board of commissioners will proceed to collect these sums at once."
