The Work of Reform.

No legislature has assembled since the adoption of the new constitution which has accomplished as much in the same space of time as the body now in session. Furthermore it is to be said that more legislation of an important character is under consideration in the present legislature than was ever found on the files of any of its predecessors.

For the first time since the constitution of 1873 became the fundamental law of the state has any effort been made by the legislature to enforce by appropriate legislation the provisions of that instrument on the subject of discrimination in charges of carrying companies. For the first time in many years have the institutions which are supported by the state's bounty been required to give an account of their expenditures before their appropriations were renewed.
