People Eating More Every Season

—A Dealer's Chat About Prices.

"Bear meat is not very salable in Philadelphia," said an old hunter and grain dealer yesterday. "We sell some to the Germans, but the average game eater does not seem to fancy it although I consider bearsteak one of the best of game foods. We get our bears from the mountains of Pennsylvania; some few come from Virginia and New York. The weather is not cold enough for venison, and the saddle we receive are 'slick.' Prime saddles bring 151 cents a pound. Just now there is considerable demand for Pennsylvania pheasant at \$1,50 and \$2 a

"The Eastern pheasants, which come to this market drawn and are used principally by the hotels and restaurants, are quoted at sixty five and seventy cents. A sudden cold snap will increase the demand for game and bring us antelope, buffalo and black and white-tailed deer from the Western ains. Antelope venison is very sweet and juicy and is being eaten more every year by epicures. Grouse are excellent food birds and we sell a great many at prices which yary from \$1.50 to \$2. Quail are not yet in prime condition and sell at \$2 to \$4.50 a dozen. Woodcock sell readily at \$7 to \$8 a dozen and there is a steady demand for them. There are occasional calls for snipe, pin tail greuse and plover. People are beginning to eat game more and more every year, and there is every indication that this season will be a prosperous one, both for the hunters and deal-


