"Refolved, That so much of the President's spreech as relates to the encouragement of manusactures, be committed to the committee of com-

merce and manufactures!

"Refolved, That so much of the President's speech as relates to the promotion of agriculture, he referred to a select committee." A committee

of three members was appointed.

"Refolved, That an enquiry be made whether any, and what further measures are necessary to reinforce the existing provisions for the discharge of the public debt." Referred to the committee of ways and means.

"Resolved, That an enquiry be made into the actual state of the sortifications, ports and harbors of the United States, and whether any and what surther provisions are necessary to be made on the subject." A committee of seven members was pointed.
