TO THE PUBLIC.

THE caution introduced into the public prints, warning all perfons against purchasing from the grantees of Blair M'Clenachan, any portion of the rge, real and perfonal eftates he conveyed away to his fon-in law and to his children was the refult of a deliberation had upon the fubject by a general and numerous meeting of the creditors as well of Blair M'Clenachan and P. It was no more than an execution of that truft confided in the fubscribers by those creditors : a flep which it would have been a breach of duty and honor in them to have omitted. The very flatement of the fast therefore muft difpel the imputation that it was either " precipitate or vindictive." It originated in a defire to fecure the property of the debtor as a fund for the payment of his just debts. It was fanctioned by the advice of council as a meafure *neceffary* to the fafety of the creditors.
