TRUST FUNDS.-The city has charge of quite a number of trust funds besides those of the kind placed, which have from time to time been placed in the hands of the authorities. Among them we notice the following: The bequest of George Emlen, made in 1776, and now in charge of the Guardians of the Poor, is intended for the purchase of wood, to be distributed to poor widows that are not assisted by any public charity, in quantity not less than half a cord, nor more than a cord, to any one person or family, for one year, from the first of the best amount to \$340 74.

THE DELAWARE, ETC.-The river Delaware is so free from ice that navigation is not at all impeded. Yesterday the wind was high and blustering from the south and southeast, and towards night some rain fell. A more disagreeable March day could not well be experienced in this latitude. The high winds, favorable for river navigation, brought quite a number of vessels engaged in the coasting and oyster trade. A decline in the price of bivalves may be anticipated. We learn that very severe weather was experienced on the coast, there being, for the past two days, and a rain squall and bitter weather, which caused much suffering among the crews of the many vessels buffeted about on the stormy ocean.
