OUR FIREMEN.—REFORMS IN THE DEPARTMENT.—A report was made to the Board of Fire Directors, last Saturday evening, by a Committee appointed to reorganize the department. They recommended to the Board the establishment of a Board of Fire Commissioners, composed of responsible citizens, and with full powers to enforce all rules for the government of the Fire Department. They also recommended a reorganization of the Fire Districts, so as to prevent too many important crossings, and other any fire that might take place. They also made some suggestions in regard to the government of the companies themselves, and asked for a further appropriation for the benefit of the steam fire companies. The report was adopted.
