Second. The jury find the engine totally inadequate to perform the work required of it without carrying a greater pressure on the boiler than it was able to bear.

In conclusion, your jury most respectfully say that they deem it entirely unnecessary, in future boiler explosions which must necessarily occur under the present system of management...
