I have heretofore cu-larged op the great value of the Northern Pacific Railroad, both to the nation and to our own State. I have devoted much time and effort to promote its success, and now hail with profound satisfaction the assurance of a speedy realization of its benefits to the State.

PORT OF ENTRY AND HARBOR ON LAKE SUPE RIOR.

With the opening of the Lake Superior and Mississippi Railroad, the town and harbor o Duluth, the terminus of the road, assume grea importance to the State. Constituting the only available port in Minnesota, on Lake Superior. we may justly claim from the General Govern-ment liberal appropriations to improve the har bor, so it shall afford adequate facilities for the large shipping and commerce that will speedly follow the opening of the road. I recommend that you memorialise Congress for the needed appropriation. Also, that you ask that Duluth be made a port of entry.

But no official honors can add to the esteem in which the retiring Governor is held by the great body of our citizens, and we feel assured that his influence, out of office or in it, will be effectually exerted, as ever, for the promotion of the public weal and for the advancement of the great principles to which he has testified so generous a devotion."
