

CITY ORDINANCES.

AN ORDINANCE To Create and Organize a Paid Fire Department for the City of Philadelphia, and to Make an Appropriation Therefor.

Section 1. The Select and Common Councils of the city of Philadelphia do ordain, That the Fire Department shall consist of seven Fire Commissioners, one Chief Engineer, five Assistant Engineers, and as many foremen, engine-men, hose-men, hook-and-ladder men, and other persons, to be divided into companies, as a member of any of the fire apparatus, and belonging to the city shall from time to time require.

CITY ORDINANCES.

Section 2. The said Fire Commissioners shall be citizens of Philadelphia, of good character, not under thirty years of age, who shall serve without compensation, and be elected as follows: Three by Select Council and four by Common Council on the last stated meeting in December, 1870. The said Commissioners, when elected, shall draw for their respective terms of office, three for the term of two years and four for the term of four years, and every second year thereafter, at their first stated meeting in the month of February, there shall be elected in the same manner three or four persons, as the case may be, by the Select or Common Council, in which the vacancy may occur, to serve for the term of four years. The minority in each Chamber shall at all times be represented by one member in a sub-board of Fire Commissioners, the said sub-board shall hold their offices until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

CITY ORDINANCES.

Section 23. That the ordinance approved January 30, 1855, entitled "An ordinance to reorganize the Fire Department of the City of Philadelphia," and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed, except so far as they may remain in temporary force under the provisions of Section 21 of this ordinance.
