

NEWS SUMMARY.

City Affairs.
—The Coroner's jury, who were so long in making up their minds in regard to the death of Elijah Stewart, killed on the Walnut street road on Saturday week, came to the conclusion that, in the first place, Mr. Stewart was killed, but whether it was the duty of the officers of the road or the plumbier to employ a signal man they were unable to determine.

—Five men, yesterday, in a small boat, were chased as far as Bridgetown by the Delaware Harbor Police. The men got out at that place and made their escape, and the boat, being captured, was found to contain a complete outfit of burglars' tools.

—There is another row at the Almshouse about the attendance of female students at the surgical clinics.

—An impostor calling himself "night inspector" tried to swindle a lady on Brown street by endeavoring to obtain a sum of money from her on the plea that a package of goods on the wharf, addressed to her, was to be sent to the bonded warehouse if she did not hand out the cash. Of course the story was a fabrication.

—Rev. E. D. Harper was yesterday installed pastor of the North Broad Street Presbyterian Church, at Broad and Green streets.

—The Supreme Lodge of Knights of Pythias closed its session on Saturday last. The next session will be held at Baltimore in April, 1872.

—An elaborately bound album, containing the portraits of the members of the different departments of the Gunston House, was on Saturday night last presented to Hon. Henry D. Moore as a testimonial of their appreciation, etc.

Explosive Affairs.
—Another explosion of nitro-glycerine has occurred at the Hoopes Tunnel, killing four men.

—The elevated railway, in New York city, was sold on Saturday, by the sheriff, to satisfy creditors.

—Ballentine's malt-house at Newark, New Jersey, was burned yesterday afternoon, involving a loss of \$60,000 and the life of the foreman.

—A committee of colored men waited on the Mayor of Cincinnati, on Saturday, and asked that some of their race be placed upon the police force of that city. The Mayor appointed four colored men station-keepers as the beginning of the experiment.

—On Saturday evening Earl De Grey was "at home" at the quarters of the English High Commissioner, and it was one of the largest receptions that ever took place in Washington. The most distinguished persons in the city were present with their ladies, and the band which was present played alternately the national airs of both countries. Taken as a whole the affair evinced the utmost cordiality between the representatives of this country and Great Britain, and led to the belief that the knotty points existing between the two countries will soon be unraveled to the entire satisfaction of each.

Foreign Affairs.
—It is announced that Menotti Garibaldi will at once return to Italy.

—A mutiny is reported to have occurred among the Communist troops.

—Fort Valerien kept up a steady fire during Saturday and yesterday.

—General Cluseret claims to have repulsed the Versailles army at all points.

—The French Assembly has passed a law providing for the payment of rentes.

—Another insurgent demonstration has been made and defeated at Versailles.

—The avenues of Paris are now constantly filled with wagons containing wounded men.

—General Durrot has arrived at Versailles with twenty thousand men of the late Imperial army.

—Five hundred million francs worth of property has been destroyed in Paris within the past few days.

—The Municipal Council of Havre has deputed three members to mediate between Paris and Versailles.

—General Cluseret offered his resignation, as the Communists have run into excesses, but it was not accepted.

—The Princess Louise, accompanied by her husband, the Marquis of Lorne, has arrived at Florence, Italy.

—There is no truth in the rumors of a ministerial modification and supplementary election to the National Assembly.

—The Commune is making immense preparations for defending the capital, in the way of embankments and barricades.

—Deputy Castellani announces that he will introduce a motion in the Cortes demanding the dethronement of King Amadeus.

—The Communists complain of nial administration of the War Office, and accuse General Cluseret of aiming at military dictatorship.

—The representatives of the commerce and industry of Paris are to make a fresh effort to conciliate the opposing factions in France.

—It is supposed that the Versailles Government intend to complete the investment of Paris, and to cut off all communication with the exterior.

—The Austrian Reichsrath has, by the adoption of a resolution, demanded of the Government the introduction of the promised bill in relation to Church and State.

—It is rumored that the Versailles Government has paid the first instalment of the war indemnity to Prussia, and that the latter is relinquishing some of the French forts.

—An arrangement was concluded on Saturday for the burial of the dead and to allow the inhabitants of Neuilly, Clichy, and other towns under bombardment to remove to places of safety.

—If the youths of Brussels do not learn to speak English it will not be the fault of a learned gentleman of this city, who has prepared a "Phonetic Book" for their instruction in the elegance of the language. This valuable work consists of long dialogues in short sentences, like those of a French novelist, and the conversation is supposed to be what is usually taken place between men and women of culture. How funny it all is may be inferred from the following extract, which gives the author's idea of English pronunciation:
