At Hayne's pottery, No. 975 North Second street, yesterday morning, Cornelius Mahoney, while carefully handling a pistol, accidentally discharged it and shot John Cox, aged twenty years, who was standing near by. Cox was taken home, at St. John and Beaver, and died shortly after. Mahoney gave himself up, and is now in custody waiting the investigation by the coroner.
