GOVERNOR OF KANSAS

The following sound and patriotic letters from Hon. J. J. Walker, accepting the appointment of Governor of Kansas, will be read with pleasure by every man who truly desires to see the peace of that Territory preserved.

WASHINGTON, March 30, 1857. Mr. BEAN Sir:—I have, at your request, reconsidered my determination, as an applicant for you, defining your terms at the office of Governor of the Territory of Kansas.

I understand that you and all your Cabinet cordially concur in the opinion expressed by me, that the actual bona fide residents of the Territory, by a fair and regular vote, unaffected by fraud or violence, must be permitted in electing their State Constitution.

I am confident that the settlement of this question by the people of the Territory, and participation of the whole people of Kansas, who should all participate freely and fully in this decision, and by a majority of whose vote the determination must be made, is the only proper and constitutional mode of adjustment.

I will go, then, and endeavor to adjust these difficulties, in the full confidence, so strongly expressed by you, that I will be sustained by all your own high authority, with the cordial co-operation of all your Cabinet.
