of our recent national victories, resulting in the capiter of Richmond and the surrender of Local army, having met agreeably to adjourn-ment at the office of Bush & Yoeum, it was Resolved, That in view of the nurder of the President and if the murderous assault upfor his Secretary of Gitate, likely to result in dealt by the hands of rabel assassins, our rejoicing has been turned into mourning; and that, there-fore, instead of processions, the firing of ear-non, Bomfires, and illuminations, for which our citizens have propared this day, the national fags new floating to the breeze over our town be lowered to half mast and, together with our public buildings, be draped; in mourning; that our pitthems be requested to close their houses and places of business from 2 to 5 of clock this afternoos, and that during that time the belies of the churches and subjic buildings be tolled.
