A Most Infamous Pledge.

The platform upon which HENRY W.

WILLIAMS, the Mongrel candidate for

Supreme Judge is rousing pledges him

to render his decisions not in accordance

with law but in accordance with right,

but in accordance with the political

opinions of the people who elected him.

And yet, it is a well known fact that

the Mongrel majority in congress will

pass an act regulating the right of suffrage

in the different States of the North

and the South. This will be done in order

to force negro suffrage upon the States

where they know that object can not be

attained by leaving it to a vote of the

people. And at this a question regulated

and controlled by State Constitutions

alone, it will necessarily be brought

before the Supreme Court of each of the

States for final decision. And if the

Judges are to decide according to the

Constitution and law, there can be no

other decision than that it is a violation

of the rights of the State, and that no

decision cannot be made by an act of

Congress. But if the decision is to be

rendered in accordance with the political

opinions of the party in power, then

will negro be given the elective

franchise, and the right of deciding as

to who shall and who shall not vote,

to be taken from the people and the States?

It is paving the way for this decision,

that this pledge is administered to their

audience. It is preparing the public

mind for this act of usurpation and

outrage - by having the corner stone
