The Election.

Thank God, light breaketh is upon the darkness that has enveloped our country for the past six years. The glorious results of Tuesday's elections, are enough to make every patriotic heart shout with joy. The verdict has been decisive—abolitionism has been doomed. As to the result in the State there can at this time be no doubt. Philadelphia has given a Democratic majority of 28%, a Democratic gain of 8,000. Berks has held up her Democratic majority to 68%. Westmoreland to 69%. Clinton to 1200, Lancaster 300, Monroe 2200, Cambria 1000, Neshaminy 1800, Clearfield 1200, Mifflin 104,—while in every abolition stronghold, heavy losses for that party are reported. In Allegany county, mongrelism loses 1200, in Erie 1700, in Chester it loses 1120, in Bradford it loses over 500, in Tioga it loses some 700, and all over the State, the same retrogress seems to have met the doomed party, whose members are now trying to hide from the just condemnation of an outraged people. A dispatch from Cleveland, Ohio to the Pittsburgh Post says, that State will elect the Democratic Governor by over 50% majority.
