

An Original Letter of George Washington a Century Old.

Messrs. Editors—The publication of the following copy of an original letter of General Washington, selected from a number in the possession of Professor A. Armstrong, of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, written to his grandfather, then resident at Carlisle, Pennsylvania, it is thought might have a peculiar interest at this time, a century having just elapsed since its date.
