

The Coming of the Chinese.

Professor Porter, of New Haven, has published the following table, showing the coming of the Chinese to this country, since 1820:

The aggregate of arrivals thus far is 105,741. Deducting the estimated number of deaths and returns to China, it would now appear that there are no less than 100,100 Chinese in this country. The rate of increase in the last four years is:

Table showing the rate of increase in the Chinese population from 1867 to 1870.

The immigration has been chiefly of males, but later immigration has brought with it a noteworthy increase of females. In the year ending June 30th, 1867, there were only eight females arrived—all to Atlantic ports. In 1868 the whole number was 46; in 1869 it was 974; in 1870, 1,116. The total arrival of females to June 30, 1870, was 2,119.

The startling figures. At the present per cent. of increase the annual influx of these heathens will be over a hundred thousand in less than five years, which would in ten years, bring us between two and three millions of these Asiatic voters, who, in twenty years, by the assistance of the fraudulent amendments of the negro party, may have the Government of our country entirely in their hands.
