THE SUPERY AND PRICE OF WHEAT - The Philadelphia Ledger says. The important fact is published that the stock of wheat at the four principal markets has greatly diminished since the European war commenced. On the 1st of January, 1870, Inverpoof, New York, Chengo and Milwankee held 15,423,000 bushels, while on the 1st of January, 1871, the stock was reduced to 10,645,000 bushels. It is also stated that the stock of wheat in London is a million bushels less than last year. This is explained by the constant drain of breadstuffs from the op posing armies. France and Germany not only conce to furnish Great Britain with what she needs, but themselves de mand a larger supply than they have The export demanded from the United States is, therefore, more peremptory than usual, as even the 50,000,000 bushels, we shipped during 1870, did not prevent a large diminution of the stock on find in British markets. Since our last crop of winter wheat was not so large as that of the preceed ing year, and the actual stock in our markets is not at present so large as usual it is not probable that prices of breadstuffs will decline, and the large exports will in some anall measure apply the loss caused by the declinand duliness in cotton.
