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The exact date for the launching has not yet been fixed, but it will probably be early in the month. The vessel was 45 per cent completed on the first of May, and it was then estimated by the naval constructors that she would be ready for launching one month later. It is expected the Pennsylvania will be given her trial trip in July, and be delivered to the government early in September.
