Treasury Surplus Disappearing.

WASHINGTON, D. C., May 6.—The treasury surplus which was \$54,000,000 at the beginning of this fiscal year, disappear today, and from now until the end of the fiscal year a deficit will be growing in its place. The total expenditures of the government since July 1st of last year have been \$460,598.98 and the total receipts up to this morning have been \$459,981,341.16, leaving a deficit this morning of \$132,-

A year ago last December the Secretary of the Treasury calculated, that there would be a surplus of about \$14,000,000 by the end of next month. When making that estimate, however, he had no knowledge that Congress would make a loop of about that Congress would make a loan of about \$5,000,000 to the St. Louis exposition, \$3,000,000 of which has already been paid out. Nor could he tell that the Panama canal payments would occur at this time.

The receipts from customs have fallen off this year by \$21,000,000, while those from internal revenue have increased only \$3,-000,000, and from miscellaneous sources the increase has been about \$4,000,000.
