#### Result of Tuesday's Election.

The usual cutting and slashing of tickets was the most prominent characteristic of Tuesday's election and in the final result the Democrats were the gainers. In Bellefonte borough the Democratic candidate for borough treasurer, James K. Barnhart, was elected over his Republican opponent, Hard P. Harris, while Samuel H. Diebl, Republican, was defeated by Thomas Howley, Democrat. Maurice A. Jackson, for auditor was elected over his Democratic opponent, S. Kline Woodring, while the Republicans also elected their candidate for high constable. In the various wards the Democrats elected one councilman and two school directors and the Republicans two councilmen and one school director, with the result that both bodies are Democratic by one majority. DANIEL MOSES STUART-Within the past two or three years we have been called upon to write the passing away of many of our most prominent men, cut

down in the vigor of life when they have but just achieved and not had time to enoy their honors and wealth-the world's measures of success. We feel they have passed before their time and are yet more sure of this in the passing of a man, younger-in the early twenties-ambitious and with ability to win all they have won. Might we not better philosophize as Cicero, 'What time? Is it that of Nature? But she, indeed, has leut us life, as we do a sum of money, only no certain day is fixed

for payment. What reason then to complain if she demands it at pleasure, since it was on this condition that we received it 17 Sudden and worthy of regret was the

death of Dau Stuart in Norfolk, Virginia last Friday morning, of heart failure, superinduced by pneumonia. The Sunday previous he had a chill but attributing it to malaria, of which he was a victim, he went to his place of business on Monday. Tuesday, however, he developed a well de fined case of grip, but his parents knew nothing of it until Wednesday evening and although his condition was not considered at all serious his mother started for Norfolk on Thursday morning. When she eached there Friday it was to find her son

dead. Pneumonia had developed and although this in itself was not apparently serous a weak heart suddenly ceased its action. How suddenly may be imagined from the fact that a few minutes before his

death he laughingly remarked that he felt well enough to sit up. At eight o'clock the family received a very encouraging telegram concerning his condition and at nine came news of his death. His mother arrived home with his body on Sunday evening and it was interred Tuesday afteruoon, at two o'clock with Mason13 honors. he being one of the few men of his years to hold a seventh degree in the State.

He was twenty-four years of age and the second son of John W. and Ella Stuart, of State College, who with two sisters and an older brother, Will, survive him.

Dan-for such he was always known in ollege and at home-was a broad hearted, genial, all-around good fellow, eagerly vigilant in the business interests of his em ployers and deservedly popular as a member of all the organizations in the town, an athlete and student in college, and a member of the Presbyterian church. In 1901, his Senior year at State College, he accepted a business opening with the H. J. Heinz Canning company, in Holland, Michigan, and for the past two years has been superintendent of the Heinz factory in Norfolk, a position which entailed big responsibilities but for which he had proven himself abundantly able. A representative of the firm from Norfolk accompanied Mrs.

Amos Garbrick 61 came to attend the funeral. This fact, to gether with a profusion of exonisite flowers was attestation of the esteem in which his employers held him. Aleres hearing ....
