CONDENSED NEWS ITEMS

Wednesday, May 20.

United States Senator Samuel Douglas McEnery was elected by the Louisiana legislature to succeed himself.

Frank E. Ferguson, of Hagerstown, Mo., was appointed assistant director of the bureau of engraving and printing by Secretary Cortelyou.

Five persons were hurt in a wreck of a Lehigh Valley passenger train at the junction of the Lehigh Valley and Buffalo, Rochester & Pittsburg railways, near Caledonia, N. Y.

Thursday, May 21.

The comptroller of the currency issued a call for the condition of national banks at the close of business on May 14.

Percy G. Marling, aged fifty-five, of Montreal, committed suicide by jumping from the window of a room in the Hotel Manhattan, in New York city.

Twenty-one persons were injured, many of them seriously, and hundreds narrowly escaped death at a performance of the Charity Circus in Chicago, when all the seats in the tent suddenly gave way.

Friday, May 22.

Joe Gans and Battling Nelson have signed articles for a forty-five-round battle, to take place in San Francisco on the afternoon of July 4.

Mrs. Fred Grothe was killed and several others more or less injured in a tornado which struck Lincoln, a small town northwest of Salina, Kan.

The business of the United States Steel corporation during April has shown an improvement over March which, as officially announced by President Gary when the annual report was made public, was considerably better than the business in February or January.

Saturday, May 23.

In the midst of an exciting game of base ball in Hazelwood, near Pittsburg, Ralph C. Barr, aged eleven, one of the players, was struck over the heart by a hard hit line drive and died almost immediately.

From the reports now in the possession of C. M. Day, president of the Denver Convention league, it is evident that more than 100,000 visitors will attend the national Democratic convention in July.

Ira Oakley, a young white man, has been arrested in Clarksville, Va., charged with the murder of Mrs. J. M. Underwood and her young son and the burning of their house at Fuquay

Spings, N. C., to conceal the crime on Feb. 1 last.

Monday, May 25.

Surrounded by a posse, Ike Watson, the negro who killed a policeman at Meridan, Miss., was riddled with bullets near Columbus, Miss.

Forty-eight per cent of the adult Indians of Alaska are suffering from tuberculosis, while practically all of the children have some disease or other.

Rev. William H. Connolly, for the past three years rector of St. Gabriel's Catholic church at Hazleton, Pa., died from kidney trouble, aged forty-four years.

Harry Russell, a ten-year-old boy, has confessed to robbing a railroad depot at Spokane, Wash., of \$500, a crime for which an aged section foreman had been arrested.

Elmer Peterson, aged seventeen, and his brother, Charles, aged sixteen, were killed in a mine of the Pennsylvania Coal & Coke company at Hastings, near Johnstown, Pa.
