

**Farm Census Agents Appointed for Centre County.**

A farm census of Centre county is now being taken under the auspices of the United States Department of Commerce in co-operation with the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture as a basis for the annual crop estimates, as well as the number of all kinds of farm stock and the total acreage of farm lands utilized as well as that lying idle.
