

CINCINNATI, March 29.—Parson Brownlow has arrived here from Tennessee and reports the rebels concentrating all the infantry formerly in East Tennessee at Tullahoma, while the Cavalry made a diversion in East Kentucky, hoping to draw a force from Rosecrans. Reinforcements are arriving daily at Tullahoma from Virginia.

Gen. Gilmore crossed the Kentucky river in force yesterday, recaptured Davisville, and is driving the rebels in the direction of Crab Orchard.

Cairo, March 27.—Last Saturday night another large, containing one thousand bushels of coal, floated past the Batteries of Vicksburg for the use of Admiral Farragut's fleet.

The Memphis Bulletin of Wednesday says that three of Admiral Porter's fleet reached the Yazoo river by the Sunflower route, and reached Greenwood.

Advices from New Orleans state that on the approach of Gen. Banks' forces the rebels retired to the Bayou. Clark of Banks' staff was severely wounded in the leg while retreating. The man who shot him was subsequently killed.
