REGULATIONS OF THE ASSESSMENT OF THE INCOME TAX.
The assessor and assistant assessors of each collection district will assess the income tax, as on the first day of May next, upon every person residing within the district liable thereto.

REGULATIONS OF THE ASSESSMENT OF THE INCOME TAX.
Persons whose income does not exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars, and who reside in the United States, will be subject to a duty of three per cent. on such portion thereof as is liable to taxation.
