PICKLES FOR THE SOLDIERS.—An exchange says: "Why not each farmer set aside a small piece of land for the soldiers—patch of Cucumbers, another of Onions and any other vegetables. We are sure the ladies will take care of them. Then in the fall make vinegar from the refuse cider, and we shall have plenty of pickles for our soldiers. Let them be sent in barrels rather than jars. They are absolutely necessary to prevent scurvy and other diseases incident to the army."

Killing Insectivorous Birds. By an Act of the Legislature of April, 1858, the killing or in any way destroying any blue bird, swallow, martin or other insectivorous bird, at any season of the year, is an offence, punished with a fine of two dollars for every violation. By the same Act, any person shall, at any time wilfully destroy the eggs or nests of any birds heretofore mentioned, within this Commonwealth, they shall for every such offence, on conviction, pay a fine of two dollars. Notwithstanding the above provisions, we notice a number of boys and men openly violating the law, and the forgiveness of God. He is a traitor of the meanest and most cowardly character, and those who sympathize with him are no better, and we think a hundred fold worse.

We sincerely hope that in Vallandigham's case every traitor, every noisy demagogue who either as an editor and stung, speaks spits forth his foul and venomous abuse against our Government, or our armies, may be speedily arrested, tried and promptly sent to the South to their Southern friends, where they properly belong. It is certainly true that the power of the Government in relation to such men should be at once tested. If there is not virtue sufficient in the Constitution to reach such infamous scoundrels, if there is not sufficient vigor in the laws to punish and exterminate the whole brood of scoundrels and demons, then the Justice of the Peace, whose duty it is to take cognizance and collect the law, for making the information the law, established fully before the world, may at any time fall a prey to such traitors. The Northern people have done good service in staying the progress of the flames, but for the want of a sufficiency of honest men, who could apply the water to the most needful place.—New Brighton Times, May 28th.

### Vallandigham, the Traitor.

Our readers will remember that this miserable demagogue and arch-traitor, who has been for a long time disturbing the peace of the loyal people of the North, was at length arrested by the order of Maj. Gen. Burnside for ventilating his treasonable and most detestable sentiments, at certain public meetings in Ohio.
