Dispatches received in the Navy Department at Washington on Saturday last from Admiral Hoff, dated at Havana, April 30th, and May 1st, state that on the 17th of April eight hundred troops commanded by Generals Letona and Escalante, arrived at Nuevitas from Villa Clara, and the day after Gen. Lesca appeared at the same place, very unexpectedly, with twelve hundred men from Buero Principe having started with 2,000, and left a detachment on the road.

They reported no resistance on the march, although large bodies of insurgents were posted on high ground some four miles from the road. A number of well constructed trenches, breast works, ditches, etc., were visible.

Dr. Simmons is still confined at Principe, accused of aiding the insurgents and giving aid and comfort to the rebels. Gen. Lesca has stated that the doctor's life was spared because he was an American.

Rear Admiral Hoff has had an interview with the Captain General of the province of Pinar del Rio, named Rafael Estrada, who, although having declared his intention of becoming an American citizen, had never taken out his final papers.
