GRANT'S AND LEE'S ARMIES LETTER FROM GEN'L, BA-DEAU. The London Standard of Oct. 12th,

publishes the following letter from Gen. Badeau; My attention has recently been drawn to an editorial article in *The* Standard for Oct. 5th, which is de-voted to Gen. Robert E. Lee. I have voice to Gen. Robert E. Lee. I have of course no right, and certainly no dedre, to depreciate the estimate put by The Standard upon either the per-sonal or, the military character of Gen. Lee; but as the article in quetion contains several statements evi-dently based upon misinformation, I venture to ask that you will allow

me to correct them in your columns. I have the less hesitation in making this request, because my principal authority for the proposed corrections is that of Gen. Lee himself.
