

Tris the boast of some of the Democratic papers that Asa Packer, whose money is said to have been used to buy his nomination, is "the Workingmen's Candidate." Says the Mauch Chunk Gazette: From 1843 to 1848, when Judge Packer was an officer in the Lehigh Coal and Navigation Company, he demonstrated his love for workmen by paying his employees in the Company's scrip at par, and redeeming it at forty per cent. discount. The poor men were obliged to submit to this ruinous share, as they could buy nothing with the scrip, and had nothing else to buy with. Thus Packer profited by their necessities to the extent of forty cents on every dollar, and in this way helped to build up his colossal fortune. We are glad to know that the present officers and management of this staunch old company do business in a different way.

RE-ASSESSMENTS.—We see it stated that the Commissioner of Internal Revenue proposes to have re-assessments made on incomes, and to commence in Philadelphia. Allow us to suggest that inquiry be made for one Asa Packer, of the Sixth ward, who is represented as a millionaire, and yet who only paid about \$40,00 in three years. It strikes us he would be a good subject to begin on, and if there are any other shirks let them all be hunted up and made to bear their honest share of the public burdens.

It may be a source of gratification to our poor people to know that in some parts of the world there is a more cheerful prospect in store for them than here, with potatoes increasing in price from week to week, and apparently without cause, unless it be that Packer may possibly buy his election next month. In the great Republican State of Iowa, potatoes are selling for twelve and one half cents a bushel, and they are not very eagerly sought for at that price.

To escape the payment of bounty tax, assessed on his immense fortune, Asa Packer played a most outrageous dodge—getting himself assessed in Philadelphia, where he returned a gold watch and a few other taxable knick-knacks which he carried along in his carpet bag! The same Asa Packer resides in a mansion which he built ten years ago in the borough of Mauch Chunk, at an expense of a hundred thousand dollars. He is the Democratic candidate for Governor.

HONEST VOTER. We ask you the wholesale plan of buying up the State of Pennsylvania—of making the ballot box a matter of merchandise—going to keep you away from the polls? Or will these hundreds of thousands of dollars from the \$20,000,000, amassed by poor payment of their taxes for their labor, make you determined that your vote shall count against such wholesale knavery?

Don't vote a selfish man Governor. Don't vote for a man who makes his private interests paramount. Don't vote for a man who grinds the faces of the poor by raising the price of coal fifty seven cents per ton, in order to add to his millions. Don't vote for a man who changes his residence to avoid paying his taxes. Don't vote for Asa Packer!!!

The Democracy are holding no public or political meeting. They do not parade as of old, or meet to reason together. They will have no expenditures this season for room-rent, music, carriages, printing, capes, torches, or the other ordinary auxiliaries of a campaign. How are they spending Asa Packer's money?
