Where a wood hub is used, if a spoke happens to become broken, it is necessary to cut the tire and separate the felloes, to get at the damaged part. The wheel must be then composed, the tire re-wheeled and reset. All this involves a considerable expense and loss of time.

In the present improvement the inner ends of the spokes are secured in an Iron Hub, which consists mainly of two shells fastened together with screws by simply passing the nuts and taking out the back shell, any one of the spokes may be removed or changed, and the hub again put together, leaving the wheel as solid and firm as ever, all within the space of a few minutes.

This method of constructing Iron Hub Wheels gives them unusual strength.
