ANOTHER REPENTANT REBEL.—The St. Louis Republican says: "Andrew J. Donelson, who will be remembered as a prominent citizen of Tennessee, and who was a candidate for the Vice-Presidency on the ticket with Millard Fillmore in 1856, recently came within the Federal lines at Nashville, took the amnesty oath, and has since been privileged to go where he pleased in that state without let or hindrance from the Federal authorities."

A large grey eagle with a bell round its neck has made its appearance near Portsmouth, New Hampshire. It is supposed to be a bird which was formerly a pet at Cape Porpoise, but which was sent on board with a sloop-barge attached to its neck, as a punishment for his frequent raids upon the chicken coops.

Three more prelates, the Archbishop of Rennes, the Bishops of Angers and the Bishop of Poitiers, have protested against the Government interdiction of the Encyclical. The document has also found a defender in Protestant Prussia. The Kreuz Zeitung regards the Pope as the highest representative of papal authority, and applauds what it calls his "courageous protest" against anti-Christian progress.
