

**THE AGRICULTURAL FAIR.**—It affords us the highest pleasure to be able to announce that our Agricultural Fair, held on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of last week, was not only a complete success, but one of the best ever held in the County. This is the more gratifying, from the fact that the notice given was so short that there was really no time for preparation and therefore, while the fair was actually the best we have ever had, it was an impromptu effort. If timely notice had been given we have no doubt, but that the show would have been far superior. Under the circumstances it was simply an exhibit of the average production of the county without special effort. Viewing it in this light we have good reason to congratulate our agricultural community on the marked progress they have made since the last fair held in this place. The show of stock was good. The display of fruit flowers and vegetables of every kind was particularly fine. Many of the vegetables could not be surpassed anywhere. There was also a very creditable show of house plants and flowers. The fruit was as fine as we have ever seen, and shows an increased interest and very creditable progress in the department of horticulture. Marked attention was attracted by fifty-six different kinds of apples, nearly all choice varieties and twenty-five different kinds of choice pears exhibited by T. M. Lynch; also a fine show of grapes and pears exhibited by Maj. D. Washburn. The finest lot of Duchesse d'Angouleme pears we have ever seen, was exhibited by Mr. Simon Lous, all grown upon a dwarf tree in his lot; were the centre of attraction in the fruit department. Premiums were awarded to Robert Montgomery for the finest basket of Seckel pears, S. S. Diehl for the finest apples and William England for the best basket of peaches. We have not yet seen the list of premiums awarded and recite these from memory of reports read on the grounds. The list of premiums will be published in full next week. General satisfaction is expressed everywhere, both with the display and the manner in which the fair was conducted. An immense crowd was in attendance each day and not a single accident or unpleasant occurrence of any kind marred the pleasure of its attendance. All seemed to enjoy the occasion and embrace the opportunity for an exchange of kindly greetings with old friends and acquaintances. We understand that it has already been determined to hold another fair next year and that timely notice will be given for the fullest participation.
