FRUITS TO SUPPLY A FAMILY.

The question is often asked, "What shall I plant in order to obtain a full supply of fresh fruit for a family the year round?"

The earliest fruits, about the first of summer, will be strawberries. A selection of the most productive sorts, well cultivated, with the runners kept off, will afford about one quart a day from each square rod for a month.

Three or four square rods, will therefore give an abundant supply for a family. Four or five hundred plants will be sufficient for this extent of ground.
