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WASH AND ASHES FOR FRUIT-TREES.

A correspondent of the Germantown Telegraph says: I have observed in some of the agricultural books quotations from your journal about "Wash for Trees," and know what you say to be the point.

I would advise as an applicant around the roots of the apple, pear, peach, quince and damson-tree, (after washing as advised by you.) sifted coal ashes, by clearing away the soil to the depth of three to five inches and inserting in its stead the sieved coal ashes.

These ashes seem to have a very damaging effect upon all kinds of worms that infest the roots of the above trees, and at the same time the effect of rejuvenating the trees.
