1. It makes four different stitches, the lock
 knot, double-lock, and double-knot, on the
 same machine. Each stitch being alike
 both sides of the fabric.

2. Every Machine has the reversible feed
 motion, which enables the operator, by simply turn-
 ing a thumb-screw, to have the work run turn-
 to the right or left, to stay any part of the seam
 or fasten, the ends of seams without turning

Q—Changing the length of stitch, and from one kind of stitch to another, can readily be done while the Machine is in motion.

A—The needle is easily adjusted, and does not skip stitches.

Q—It is almost needless, and can be so where quiet is necessary.

A—Its motions are all positive; there are no springs to get out of order, and its simplicity enables any one to operate it.

Q—It does not require finer thread on the under side for the upper side, and will sew across the heaviest seam, or from one to more thickness of cloth, without change of needle, tension, or using thread, or skipping stitches.

Q—The Hammer is easily adjusted, and will turn any width of hem desired.

Q—No other Machine will do so many kinds of work as the Florence.

A—It will hem, fell, blind gather, brand, quilt and gather and sew on a ruffle at the same time. It has no springs to get out of order, and will last a lifetime.

The taking up of the slack-thread is not performed by the irregular contraction of a wire or uncertain operation of springs. The precision and accuracy with which the Florence draws the thread into the cloth is unapproached by any Sewing-Machine hitherto offered in the world.

We furnish each Machine with "Baron's Sewing Sewer," which guides the work itself, and is of incalculable value, especially to inexperienced operators.

While possessing the above, and many other advantages, the Florence is sold at correspondingly low prices, and first-class quality is guaranteed.

and lock stitches, and has the reversible feed.

No. 2, Florence.—Gold-ornamented Machine,
with tracer, and light cover, without lock;
makes all the four stitches, and has the re-
versible feed.

No. 3.—Silver-plated Machine, ornamented;
table oil-finished walnut, with heavy half-
cover, with tracer, and light cover, without
stitches, and has the reversible feed.

No. 4.—Silver-plated Machine, highly orna-
mented, and makes all the four stitches,
and has the reversible feed.
